


Amazing animals, fun environment, and great new merchandise!

Gertie is in her forever home

When Ally Garbe, Operations Assistant at Paws+Claws Rescue & Resort, convinced her parents Lisa and Bill Garbe to foster Gertie, most of our staff figured it would be foster failure and that the Garbes would eventually end up adopting Gertie. Lisa was adamant that they were just nursing Gertie back to health and taking care of her until she found her forever, we smiled and nodded knowing the truth.

Lisa volunteers at Paws+Claws once a week, helping us with answering phones and filing paperwork. Each week she would come in with pictures of Gertie and a new story of something cute and fun she did. The Garbes have another German Shepherd named Nadjia "Naughty Dog" who quickly became best friends with Gertie. After Gertie was fitted with a cart to improve her mobility, Lisa told us how the two girls would run after each other down the hill to see who could get to the bone first and if Gertie won, she would trot off with her bone and bury it by the tree. Naughty is one of the best companions that Gertie could ask for -- she sleeps downstairs with Gertie and stops to wait for her if Gertie starts to fall behind when they go out for a walk.

Gertie also fell in love with Bill Garbe and follows him wherever he goes. When Bill goes out to work in the shop, Gertie will go down the couple stairs off of the porch and follow him across the yard. When Bill gets in the truck to go to a job, Gertie does her best to get in the truck, too. She will get her front half up in the truck and then sit and look at Bill while she waits for him to pick up her back half and the cart.

When Lisa came in and said that they couldn't imagine their home without Gertie in it, we knew that this was the best possible ending for her story. "We feel so blessed for the opportunity to give Gertie her best life. Every day she makes our family smile mostly because she smiles all day," Lisa said. Gertie went from a dog who was abandoned and unable to walk, to a energetic dog who will live out the rest of her life in a home with two humans who love her, a four-legged sister, and so many others to visit and dote on her.

We also have to thank our volunteers who come to help in the many aspects of running our shelter, our staff for the work they do for these animals every day, our social media followers for sharing our posts, and our community for their ongoing support. In whatever way you help Paws+-Claws, please know how much it is appreciated.

We are quickly approaching the end of the year, and all of the generosity, compassion, and devotion that the season brings. As you are looking for a place to contribute year-end gifts, we ask that you keep Paws+Claws in mind. Your gifts are essential for helping our pets to be happy and healthy and allowing us to find their forever homes.

Gertie, a German Shepherd that came in to Paws+Claws this summer, is a perfect example of a pet supported by your gifts. We received a report in early June saying a dog had been left at Powers Township Hall in Backus, MN; we arrived to find her dragging her hind end. Upon a veterinary examination, we found out she had advanced, untreated arthritis, untreated Ehrlichia and Lyme disease, and had been shot twice – once with buck shot, scattered across her left side, and a pellet in her left front shoulder.

After a lot of TLC and being placed in a foster home, we are happy to say that Gertie's condition, and her life, have greatly improved. "She went from dragging herself everywhere she went to trotting across the yard trying to keep up with her "dad" Bill within days of arriving," states Lisa Garbe, Gertie's foster mom. Thanks to a cart purchased with donated funds, Gertie now has increased independence and youthfulness, along with finding her competitive side – she can often be found chasing down her foster sister Naughty to try reaching their bone first when playing fetch. Lisa said it best about seeing Gertie's transformation and how they decided to adopt her: "Watching her work so hard to be mobile has been a testament to the heart and courage of this dog! Gertie is so smart, kind, loving and courageous and brought so much joy to our family – she is in her forever home."

Your donations allowed us to pay for Gertie's medical needs and her care while she was a foster pet and helped her make her transformation, as well as providing for the health and wellbeing of all other pets in our care. 

Pet Health and Safety Reminders Winter 2019-2020

Do not leave space heaters on unattended or near your pets. This can easily get knocked over and burn your pet or become a fire hazard.

It is best to continue using flea & tick and heartworm preventatives year round. You won't be out of the routine once spring comes and this way your pets will always be covered.

Do not leave pets outside in cold weather. Pets can get frostbite as quickly as humans do in cold temperatures. If it's too cold for you, it's too cold for your pet.

Watch for antifreeze leaks and other harmful toxins.*

Be cautious of rodenticides and cold weather poisons.*

*Must be 12 or older to volunteer with an adult or 16 or older to volunteer on your own.








Paws+Claws Staff Christmas Paw-rty
